a. Food Pantry

Report Given by Stephen Harper, Director of food pantry :

- The first official delivery is coming on 10/10 at 12pm. It will be a large shipment because it is the second Thursday of the month. Following shipments will be smaller.
- Official opening will be on Monday 14/10
 - Eden Prairie did not order food, so the shipment was late. Because of this issue Stephen Harper as the director and will take on the responsibility of ordering food.
 - CCX will be on campus to record the opening of the food pantry on 14/10, interviews from Senate President and Director Stephen Harper. They will also be taking B roll footage and record around campus
 - The late start on the food pantry was largely due to licensing issues.
 - End of October there will be a grant Stephen will apply for to get an additional \$20,000 for ordering food
 - Ready-made meals will be stored in the Student Life Center Refrigerator, dry goods and produce will be kept in the pantry.
 - Monday, Tuesday, and Thursday for the first week
 - Monday, Wednesday, and Friday after the first week.
